1. TOWARDS A SHARED VISION

The fundamental theme of the management strategy of the nominated serial property, is to enhance the variety of relationships that unite the gypsum karst areas of the Northern Apennines in a unitary, coordinated and World Heritage oriented system.

The name of the candidate property underlines the importance of this unitary key and highlights the representative characters constituted by the set of component sites united in a coherent system.

The first part of the name - **Evaporitic Karst and Caves** - indicates the vast presence of particularly representative geological features, both epigean and hypogean.

The second part - **of Northern Apennines** - indicates the belonging of the property to a region of the Earth well-identified both from the geographical-cultural and climatic point of view.

Moreover, in parallel to the preparation of the nomination document, the Region has promoted a participatory process involving all territories, which led in 2020 to the signing of an **Memorandum of Understanding** * (RER Repertoire n. 149 registered on 27/04/2020), further expanded in 2021 with the addition of new territories to the nomination project.

The MoU constitutes the **programmatic document of the vision of the nomination project** and manifests the undersigned entities' commitment to support and sustain the nomination in every phase, cooperating and harmonizing their actions in the territory.

The vision expressed by the MoU commits the signatories to work together, according to their role and their area of competence, to promote actions, projects, programs, and strategies towards:

- *The protection of the environmental balance and safeguard of the epigean and hypogean ecosystems;*
- *The protection and conservation of geological sites and specific geological landscape of the gypsums;*
- *The enhancement of the historical, cultural, social, and archaeological aspects of the territories; environmental education of the local people and visitors to the protected and adjacent areas;*
- *A sustainable development of the territory through best practices and promotion of compatible economic activities.*

2. PARTICIPATORY PROCESS AND STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

From the beginning, the nomination project was set up with an inclusive approach that actively and continuously involved all interested stakeholders.

The stakeholders were identified and selected from among them, who have direct and indirect management responsibility for the candidate areas and territories of the nominated property, distinguishing between:

- I. **key stakeholders**, represented by the two lead management authorities directly responsible for the nominated property, i.e. the Emilia-Romagna Region and the Apennino Tosco-Emiliano National Park;
- II. **institutional stakeholders**, i.e. all the administrative authorities of the territories in which the candidate areas are located;
- III. **operating stakeholders** and **supporters**, i.e. all those who, in different ways, can actively collaborate in support of the property as parks, universities and research bodies, environmental associations, speleological groups, schools and educational centres, economic and tourist operators, individuals, etc.

Each of these stakeholder categories has followed a different engagement process based on specific tasks and roles. At technical level, the involvement of the several regional departments occurred through a series of interdepartmental work meetings. At political level, the involvement process of institutional stakeholders led to the signing of the aforementioned *Memorandum of Understanding* that commits all institutions to implement the actions necessary to support the nomination, forming the basis for creating the organs of governance. The authorities signing the agreement constitute the **Institutional Coordination Committee** (see the governance organization diagram) which has the essential task of agreeing on the management strategy. Concerning the operating stakeholders, most are part of the **Technical Scientific Working Group** (executive act no. 12029 of 25/07/2018 and renewal act no. 17425 of 22/08/2021), formally established to contribute with studies, in-depth analysis and research to the nomination documents.

3. GOVERNANCE PROJECT

The shift in perspective from local heritage to world heritage is the leitmotif of the management strategy. The main contents are: the definition of a governance dedicated to the nominated serial property and the elaboration of a coordinated management system oriented to the conservation, enhancement and promotion of geoheritage for the benefit of future generations, through procedures of participation and involvement of stakeholders.

There are several contextual conditions that must be considered to ensure the most effective management model. In the case of the serial site of **Evaporitic karst and caves of the Northern Apennines** there are multiple aspects to be taken into account according to the characteristics of the different managing bodies and the objectives (mission) related to the World Heritage status.

The purpose of governance is to establish stable forms of collaboration among the current management authorities of the nominated serial property.

In order to ensure a unitary and homogeneous management, various possible alternatives have been considered, taking inspiration from the governance models available in World Heritage and/or international contexts. In particular, various management examples of other complex territories with physical and administrative characteristics similar to those of the candidate property were analysed:

- a. properties with geological value of global importance (World Heritage List sites according to criterion viii; UNESCO Global Geoparks geosites);
- b. serial properties (Italian and European serial sites inscribed in the World Heritage List; sites inscribed in the MaB programme);

On the basis of these criteria some case studies have been identified among the World Heritage serial properties which appear significant for management aspects such as:

- Caves of Aggtelek Karst and Slovak Karst (HUN-SVK);
- South China Karst (CHN), Škocjan Caves (SVN);
- The Dolomites (ITA);
- Primeval Beech Forests of the Carpathians and Other Regions of Europe (ALB, AUT, BEL, BIH, BGR, HRV, CZE, FRA, DEU, ITA, POL, ROU, SVK, SVN, ESP, CHE, UKR);
- Getbol, Korean Tidal Flats (KOR).

In addition to the governance examples offered by the serial sites included in the WHL, the current administrative-managerial characteristics of the components of the EKCNA serial site should also be considered in the evaluation.

3.A. THE CURRENT GOVERNANCE

The current system of governance consists of two main administrative authorities: the Appennino Tosco-Emiliano National Park (c.s.1) and the Emilia-Romagna Region (c.s.2-7).

The Appennino Tosco-Emiliano National Park is directly supervised by the Italian Ministry for Ecological Transition.

The component sites 2 - 7 are under the control of the Emilia-Romagna Region which directly supervise the management authorities of the regional protected areas. These management authorities (called Management Authority for Parks and Biodiversity of Central Emilia, Eastern Emilia and Romagna) are also responsible for implementing the specific conservation measures for the Natura 2000 sites that fall within their jurisdiction. Every management authorities owns a management plan, a specific budget and a dedicated staff (technical and administrative) to manage and control the respective areas. In addition, the National Park is the coordinator of the Appennino Tosco-Emiliano Biosphere Reserve UNESCO, which entirely includes c.s.1 and part of c.s.2 of the nominated serial property.

The following table summarizes the current management structure of the candidate serial property by relating the management authorities to the respective protected areas.

In the two columns on the left are listed the management authorities; in the two columns on the right, the component sites and the corresponding protected areas.

In summary, only component site 1. "Alta Valle del Secchia" is not under the responsibility of the Emilia-Romagna Region.




3.B. THE PROPOSED GOVERNANCE

The proposed governance system brings together the existing forms of management, without overlapping them, but creating a new coordination structure that can effectively converge the various park management bodies on shared objectives.

Considering that only the Appennino Tosco-Emiliano National Park does not depend on the Emilia-Romagna Region, the degrees of difficulty at the organisational-management level appear limited. Moreover, the decades-long collaboration between the National Park and the Emilia-Romagna Region and between the National Park and the Regional Parks - officialized by partnership protocols - is already in place for specific activities, such as participation in European projects or monitoring activities.

In this governance model, the bodies are hinged in the institutional chain (lead by Emilia-Romagna Region) that ensures the legal coverage and is the main referent subject. The connection with the other bodies that already administer and manage the various component sites should be formalized through a **Programme Agreement** (*art. 34 of Legislative Decree no. 267 of August 18, 2000 "Unified text of the laws on the organization of local authorities"*).

The flowchart below shows the functional relationships between the different agencies responsible for the main protected areas. At the moment there is no direct relationship between the National Park and the Regional Protected Areas System, although there are many common actions. The flowchart on facing page represents the implementation of the **Programme Agreement**.




The diagrams also highlight the relationships with other Departments whose competences are relevant to the World Heritage (such as, for example, the geology, the landscape, the urban planning, the environmental protection, the impact assessment, the hydrology protection, etc.)

Such a Programme Agreement has the advantage of being an instrument of coordination between entities provided for by the national legal system that legitimizes the start-up of projects between communities and territorial actors of the various areas, as well as being very light and flexible to different contents.

In the Italian context, there are several examples of a similar scheme (although related to historical urban centres and cultural heritage), which allow us to observe the effectiveness of this solution.

This Agreement between the Emilia-Romagna Region and the Ministry of Ecological Transition / Appennino Tosco-Emiliano National Park will establish the methods, times, and forms of coordination of the management and actions for the protection/enhancement/promotion of the property, including other very important management elements such as the administration/seeking of funding, the financing of activities, the provision of a current management fund, etc. The Agreement will be defined in detail at the end of a sharing process.

To ensure the coordination between the two key stakeholders, an office exclusively dedicated to World Heritage and hinged in the regional administrative structure chain, will be established : the EKCNA WH Site Office.



Since all areas of the nominated serial property are located in the administrative territory of the Emilia-Romagna Region, the establishment of a management coordination office represents a "light" solution that does not require the formation of a Director Board, new management bodies or external support roles. Moreover, as shown in the following table of Human Resources, it can be quickly set up using human and financial resources which are available within the existing Administrations.

The involvement of stakeholders (non-institutional or NGOs) in conservation, management and promotion guidelines for the nominated property is guaranteed through the establishment of specific supporting bodies that involve universities and research centres (UNI GeoLab), or that engage individuals and associations (EKCNA WH club) in research, promotion and monitoring activities of the geological heritage.

The Office in charge of coordinating/managing the nominated WH Site must exercise coordination activities between the various implementing subjects (the Park and Biodiversity Management Authorities), which in turn are subject to the control of the Emilia-Romagna Region through the Department for Protected Areas, Forests, and Mountain Development, which also directly manages the Natura 2000 Network sites. Therefore, in order to be able to effectively exercise the role of guidance and management co-ordination among different implementers, the EKCNA WH Site Office will be provided with the best available coordination.

3.C THE GOVERNANCE TASKS

The tasks of the governance system of a World Heritage site are summarized below:

- referent/focal point towards the World Heritage Committee and towards the Ministry of Ecological Transition;
- elaboration of periodic reports on the state of conservation of the property and on the evaluation of the maintenance of the Outstanding Universal Value over time;
- elaboration and monitoring of the Management Strategy for the promotion of conservation, valorization and sustainable management;
- referent/focal point between the various subjects/implementing bodies to coordinate the implementation of the management strategy, with particular regard to:
 - a. coordination of interventions for the conservation of attributes and values related to Criterion (viii);
 - b. coordination of interventions for the enhancement and promotion of the property;
 - c. coordination of interventions for communication and awareness.
- promotion and coordination of links between implementing subjects and public and/or private stakeholders, operating in the territory of the property;
- implementation and monitoring of projects financed by Law no. 77 of February 20, 2006, "Special measures for the protection and use of Italian sites of cultural, landscape and environmental interest included in the "World Heritage List";
- promotion, implementation and coordination of studies and research on the conservation of the territory and its natural heritage.

On the following pages, a synoptic table shows the human resources dedicated to the nominated property. The table represents the outcome of a survey conducted by regional and park technical facilities and reflects the current staff employed in the management of each component site of the serial property, divided by full-time and part-time staff. Rangers constitute a separate specialized unit and serve under specific agreements.

4 DRAFT STRATEGY FOR THE MANAGEMENT COORDINATION

4.A. THE CURRENT COORDINATION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

All protected areas and Natura 2000 Network sites that make up the nominated serial property have a management plan or regulations to implementing protective measures as prescribed by European legislation.

At the regional level, the management coordination of protected areas is implemented through two main general instruments, the "Programme for the Regional System of Protected Areas and Natura 2000 Network sites" (Programme) and the "Regional Landscape Territorial Plan" (PTPR).

The focus of the Programme is the conservation and promotion of regional biodiversity and is therefore directed to the environmental characteristics. The focus of the Landscape Plan is the protection of the landscape and is therefore oriented at safeguarding the relationship between man and environment, regulating human activities and land use.

PROGRAMME FOR THE REGIONAL SYSTEM OF PROTECTED AREAS AND NATURA 2000 NETWORK SITES

The harmonization of the various protected areas regulations takes place on the basis of the "Programme for the Regional System of Protected Areas and Natura 2000 Network sites" (Programme), provided for by art. 12 of the L.R. n. 6/2005. The Programme is the strategic tool that determines the regional policy on nature conservation and protected areas. The main objective is to establish the conditions to promote coordinated actions among the different categories of protected areas. The relationships concern both biological and ecosystemic aspects and opportunities for use, economic complementarities, etc.

The strategic and specific objectives, the actions, and the instruments of the Programme are the result of the consultation with the main cultural, social and institutional actors in the regional society and are inspired by the main treaties, agreements, programs, and directives defined at international, community and national level regarding the conservation of biodiversity.

The **Programme** establishes:

- the definition of the state of conservation of the natural heritage included in the system;
- the priorities for the management of the regional system of protected areas and Natura 2000 Network sites;
- the financial framework as a three-year regional program of investments in favour of the protected of the system of protected areas and Natura 2000 Network sites;
- the criteria for the distribution of regional contributions for the operation of the individual protected areas;
- the identification of the areas to be allocated to regional parks, nature reserves, protected natural and semi-natural landscapes, and ecological rebalancing areas;
- the identification of ecological connection areas at the regional level;
- any territorial modifications to existing protected areas;
- the definition of the purpose objectives of the existing protected areas.

REGIONAL LANDSCAPE TERRITORIAL PLAN (PTPR) – 1993 (REVISION IN PROGRESS)

For the areas involved in the nominated property, the **Regional Landscape Territorial Plan (PTPR)**, represents the reference planning tool for the verification of the current landscape-environmental protections.

The PTPR (approved by Regional Council Resolution n.. 1388 dated January 28th 1993 and n. 1551 dated July 14th, 1993) of the Emilia -Romagna Region is a territorial plan focused on the landscape and the environmental values.

This plan identifies the large subdivisions of physiographic types (mountain, hill, plain, coast), the thematic systems (agricultural, forest, water, settlement), and the biological, geomorphological, or settlement components that for their persistence and resistance to change, were placed as ordering elements of the growth and transformation of the regional territorial structure. It imposes constraints, directives and prescriptions that are directly effective with regard to the Provinces, Municipalities and individuals and establishes provisions aimed at protecting the entire regional territory in order to pursue the following objectives:

- *to preserve the recognizable connotations of the historical event of the territory in its complex relationships with the settled populations and with human activities;*
- *to guarantee the quality of the environment, natural and man-made, and its collective usage;*
- *to ensure the protection of the territory and its primary physical, morphological and cultural resources;*
- *to identify the actions necessary for the maintenance, restoration and integration of landscape and environmental values, including through the implementation of specific plans and projects.*

The regulations of the PTPR prevail over the regulations of subordinate plans (provincial, municipal and inter-municipal ones).

The Region is currently engaged together with the Ministry of Cultural Heritage in the process of adaptation of the PTPR in force to the Code of Cultural Heritage and Landscape (Legislative Decree 42/2004). A digital copy of the Plan Regulations is included in the Annexes (see Annexes, folder A-7b). All Plan documentation (reports, cartography, inventories, data, etc.) are available at the webpage <https://territorio.regione.emilia-romagna.it/paesaggio/PTPR>.

REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE ACTIVITIES IN THE SEVEN COMPONENT SITES.

In all component sites of the nominated property, there are very similar, if not the same, regulations. This substantial homogeneity is the effect of the application of the Programme for the Regional System of Protected Areas and Natura 2000 Network sites (see the previous paragraph) and of the Regional Landscape Territorial Plan prescriptions.

The only authorized activities are exploration, scientific research, and educational dissemination.

The transformations related to human activities present in some areas (traditional agriculture, forest management, and land security) are subject to specific authorizations of the competent Authorities (parks authorities and local authorities). In the Natura 2000 network sites, any human activity that may have an environmental impact is subject to a preventive environmental impact assessment (the "Valutazione d'Incidenza Ambientale" - VINCA) that determines whether the transformation is acceptable and - if so - what measures should be taken to mitigate the impact. The opening and operation of quarries, mines and landfills, as well as the removal of minerals is forbidden in the entire property by park regulations and spatial landscape planning.

On the following pages, there is a summary of the main rules governing the activities in the seven component sites taken from the primary tools for implementing conservation measures, such as the management plans of the three natural Parks, the specific regulations of the Natural Reserve and Protected Landscape, the protection measures of the Natura 2000 sites. Full versions of the management plans and regulations are attached (see Annexes, folder A-7.b.).

4.B OVERALL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

The perspective introduced with the nomination project considers the evaporitic karst areas of the Northern Apennines as connected by genetic relationships to form a coherent and correlated whole. The management plans of each protected area - together with the existing coordination tools - ensure the protection of all component sites. Thus, the central focus of the proposed overall management strategy is the coordination of management actions already applied and their orientation to World Heritage requirements.

Key management issues include the protection of the attributes and values of the geoheritage, conservation measures for habitats and species of Community interest, knowledge and communication of the environments, education and enhancement of the visitor experience. The central aim is the maintenance of the integrity of the nominated serial property as a whole, so the proposed strategy is articulated following some concepts widely shared at international level: conservation and protection / valorisation / communication.

The presence of stratified competences and forms of management on the candidate property also requires a coordinated and inclusive management strategy.

The coordination principles of the proposed management strategy are the following:

- developing existing collaboration among protected areas (see the collaboration experience of the LIFE Gypsum project);
- networking knowledge and experience between Regional Park and National Park Management Authorities;
- enhancing geological scientific value by focusing on seriality and connecting factors among the component sites;
- applying principles of connectivity conservation to reinforce the value of the seriality;
- applying principles of social equity and inclusion to give opportunities of experience to people with disabilities;
- supporting the sustainable development of the territory through best practices of collaboration and compatible uses of the territory.

5. SHARED ACTION PLAN

The project has identified a number of central themes on which to converge the experience and expertise already present locally through mutual collaboration. The aim is to build widespread knowledge and awareness of the outstanding universal values, both among the resident population and among visitors.

The actions identified, to be activated in a coordinated manner, relate to the following themes:

GEOHERITAGE:

1. protection of the continuity of epigean and hypogean ecosystems;
2. promotion of in-depth and coherent knowledge of the geological values spread over the territory as an exceptional testimony of the Earth's history (e.g. inventory of speleothems);
3. identification of unitary principles of geo-heritage protection to be included in planning instruments (e.g. by integrating the perimeter of the serial property in the planning cartography);

4. strengthening common geoprotection measures to be applied locally;
5. activation of exchange and collaboration with other World Heritage sites that are comparable in scientific or organisational terms.

GEO TOURISM:

1. increasing the quality of tourism (both domestic, neighbouring the property, and incoming tourism) by managing present-day flows and improving attractiveness (e.g. by creating visitor itineraries that combine and summarize elements of both epigean and hypogean geological values);
2. defining a visual identity project of the serial property to promote the understanding of geologic values to the broader public;
3. promoting accessibility to the property by persons with disabilities and the application of inclusive design principles for visiting facilities (interpretation centres, outdoor museum routes, accessible nature routes, etc.)
4. reinforcing the attractiveness by creating routes (geo-trails) that cover all the geological values;
5. introducing practices of "geocaching" and design of applications/software for the understanding of the geological value of each component of the serial property;
6. promoting the network of interpretation centres and thematic museums, for the dissemination of the geological value of the nominated property;
7. promoting the network of tourist facilities (refuges, guest houses, B&Bs, restaurants, refreshment points, etc.).

KNOWLEDGE AND TRAINING:

1. promoting the knowledge of geological values of the nominated property through school education and the professional training of operators;
2. promoting the knowledge of the UNESCO values, associated with the status of world heritage, through school education and the professional training of operators;
3. promoting the creation of the network of museums in the territory;
4. promoting the creation of a computerised repertoire (bibliographic, photographic, iconographic) specific to the EKCNA site, according to the OUV;

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION BETWEEN THE SINGLE COMPONENTS:

1. to reduce anthropogenic pressure factors and the conservation of the natural heritage based on the exemplary experiences of parks and protected areas;
2. to orientate conservation activities and the promotion of the territory's values towards a progressive integration of the actions promoted by the individual management bodies;
3. to identify good practices developed by each park or protected area and extension to all the component sites of the serial property.

6. FINANCING SOURCES

For the nomination project, the technical offices of the administrations and parks have analyzed in detail the resources currently allocated to each component site of the serial property, also highlighting possible sources of future funding for the next seven years. The result of this analysis is the base for the paragraph on financial resources in chapter 5 of the nomination dossier, which is included here in its entirety.

This analysis is also the basis for the development of a specific sustainable financing plan for the nominated serial property, which is an integral part of the overall management strategy. The financing plan will identify the public and private funding sources, develop a set of activities for resourcing, and define the steps for the activation of multi-year funding programmes.

6.A ECONOMIC FRAMEWORK OF THE NOMINATED PROPERTY

The financing sources of the nominated areas are public, namely national, regional and municipal.

The Emilia-Romagna Region is the main source of financing as it directly manages most of the candidate territory. At present, the Region contributes 84% of the current expenditure and 65% of the capital expenditure. The average annual budget (calculated over the period of the last 5 years) is about 1,100,000 € (about 300 €/ha), nearly exactly balanced in half between current and capital expenditure.

In addition to this ordinary funding, must be mentioned the Region's special investment programs for regional protected areas and, in perspective, national funds for the conservation and enhancement of World Heritage List sites, established by Law n. 77/2006.

In particular, for the three years 2021-2023, the Region has approved an "Investment Programme for Parks and Protected Areas" intended for projects of environmental requalification and

enhancement and biodiversity conservation. This three-years investment programme is planned by the Programme for the Regional System of Protected Areas and Natura 2000 Network sites.

Furthermore, the Region has recently approved the PAF - Prioritised Action Frameworks - a strategic document that is an integral part of the new programming cycle of the European Funds for 2021-2027. Based on the PAF, for the next seven years, the Natura 2000 sites belonging to the nominated Property will count on specific investments for carrying out concrete actions of protection, regulation, monitoring, training, and dissemination.

Finally, National Law n.77/2006 supports specific interventions for the protection, promotion and enhancement of the Italian UNESCO sites. In particular the Law supports the elaboration of management plans for listed sites, which entail special measures for the OUV conservation.

Thanks to these programmes and this national law, the additional funding earmarked for nominated areas could reach around one million euros per year.

7. COORDINATED MONITORING

Development of monitoring protocols to be applied across all component sites of the candidate property. Identification of priority issues to be monitored and selection of key indicators. A long-term monitoring system has been set up, using ground- and underground-based observations, for improved evaluation of ecological state of karst aquifers, seismo-tectonic movements and climate cave conditions. Key aspects of the property's flora and fauna are also monitored. As with the definition of the economic framework, for the nomination project the technical offices of the administrations and parks have drawn up an analytical inventory of all the monitoring programs currently in place in the nominated areas, based on a set of indicators significant for monitoring pressures. The set of indicators was chosen on the basis of the pressure factors contained in the List of factors affecting the properties adopted by the World Heritage Committee. The indications of the international literature were also taken into account.

The result of this analysis is the basis for the chapter on monitoring in the nomination dossier. This analysis is also the basis for the development of future monitoring protocols based on specific indicators.

KEY INDICATORS FOR MEASURING STATE OF CONSERVATION

The major part of the factors influencing the geo-heritage state of conservation concern not only the nominated phenomenon, but also the wide area that contains the Property and the various elements that contribute to the natural evolution of the karst features in the Northern Apennines (e.g. climatic aspects).

For this reason, monitoring activities are carried out both at regional and national level by land management and protected areas agencies; some factors are also monitored at European level. At the moment, the main aspects that directly and indirectly influence the conservation of the entire geo-heritage in the nominated area are investigated by monitoring:

- caves
- streams and rivers
- gravitational mass movement and erosion phenomena
- earthquakes
- weather and climate
- forest cover and land use
- tourism pressure
- access roads and trails.

Details of the agencies and institutions responsible for monitoring, and the frequency of the surveys, are given in the attached table.

7.A. GEOLOGY AND HYDROGEOLOGICAL VULNERABILITY

The factors determining geological and hydrogeological vulnerability were considered on the basis of the scientific literature on geomorphological and karst phenomena monitoring (EPA - Quinlan J.F. 1989; IGRAC 2008; RER 2005; Renard K. G. et al. 1997).

These factors can affect the candidate phenomenon both negatively and positively. On the one hand, they may record or determine the physical disappearance and fragmentation of key attributes; or they may affect the physical accessibility of caves. On the other hand, the same factors may also create the conditions for the discovery of new caves or exposing new attributes.

The key indicators are developed in detail in par. 6.a.1 of the nomination Dossier.

7.B. HABITATS AND CLIMATE

The ecological conditions of habitats are very useful indicators for monitoring the conservation status of underground karst systems. Monitoring is carried out at the regional level with the support of universities and speleological associations. Climate factors play also have an important role on the state of conservation of the underground cave system, in relation to two elements that characterise the karst phenomenon:

- d. at the hypogea level, the interaction between precipitation and the underground water circulation system;
- e. at epigean level, in relation to the geographical-climatic location of the phenomena. In fact, this second factor distinguishes the nominated property from many other sites with similar karst phenomena (see par. 3.2).

The monitoring of these global factors, which are not influenced by anthropogenic activities of local origin, is continuously carried out both at the regional and the national level, so that their effects are known. It should also be emphasized that constant monitoring of cave climate indicators (temperature and humidity) provides information on the response of underground karst systems to global climate change.

The key indicators are developed in detail in par. 6.a.2 of the nomination Dossier.

7.C. HUMAN ACTIVITIES

Human activities affecting the state of conservation of the nominated area can be grouped into two macro-categories. The first one is directly related to the exploitation of subsoil resources (quarrying activities). These activities, which can potentially alter or destroy the geo-heritage, are very localised and are strictly regulated by the regional legislation (see par. 5.d); the few existing activities outside the core areas are permanently monitored at the regional level.

Agricultural activity, which is much less invasive but a little more widespread, is however regulated and monitored at the regional level and at the level of the single Park or protected area. The second macro-category includes the effects deriving from proximity to intensely anthropized areas (settlements, tourist attractions, pollution, depression from abandonment). These factors produce differentiated forms of pressure on individual component sites and do not occur in a diffuse form but a few well-localized places. In these locations, the combination of pressure factors could lead locally to the alteration or loss of legibility of the processes or attributes that contribute to the exceptional geologic value. However, these situations are known, and continuous monitoring ensures that pressure factors are kept under control.

The key indicators are developed in detail in par. 6.a.3 of the nomination Dossier.

7.D. OTHER FACTORS

Communication of the speleological and geological values of the nominated property is strategic to its conservation. Monitoring the communication of values and attributes, which constitute the basis of the outstanding scientific value, ensures sufficient information - about the site as a whole and its individual components - to meet the requirements of all stakeholders, from the specialist to the generalist groups. The key indicators are developed in detail in par. 6.a.4 of the nomination Dossier.

7.E. ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS FOR MONITORING PROPERTY

Generally, the current administrative arrangements for monitoring the state of conservation within the nominated property can be considered adequate for the evaporitic karst values and attributes. As noted, all the 7 component sites are located within Parks (national and regional) or Natura 2000 Network protected areas, whose management plans clearly establish the monitoring framework for biotic aspects (habitats and climate) and those related to educational and training activities (education and communication). Regarding the geological and hydrogeological aspects, the monitoring of karst systems is regulated at regional and national level, including aspects related to human activities pressure.

The National Institutes, Regional Agencies, management Authorities, and Associations guarantee a constant survey frequency and the indicators used are fully relevant to the objectives of protection and conservation of the geo-heritage. The public administrations and structures from which the data populating the indicators are collected are listed in the followin table.

7.F. RESULTS OF PREVIOUS REPORTING EXERCISES

There are many reports of environmental monitoring related to protected areas and Natura 2000 habitats, carried out by parks and protected areas management bodies. The activities are **the monitoring of flora and fauna characteristic of cave environments** (such as bat populations), **the biological monitoring of the groundwater fauna** ("Trias project") but also **of water quality and anthropic activities** (such as agricultural or mining exploitation). Several monitoring reports were produced as part of European projects by one or more parks in collaboration with the Emilia-Romagna Region or research institutes.

The LIFE+GYPSUM project (2010-2016) is particularly significant. It has involved several of the component sites: the Gessi Bolognesi e Calanchi dell'Abbadessa Regional Park as project leader, the Appennino Tosco-Emiliano National Park, the Vena del Gesso Romagnola Park, and the Onferno Nature Reserve. For this reason, it represents a considerable coordination experience among the protected areas of the nominated property. As part of the project, several monitoring activities have been carried on the habitats associated with gypsum outcrops characterized by karst phenomena.

Generally, considering that 6 out of 7 sites are under the direct responsibility of the Emilia Romagna Region, which ensures the entire administrative chain and manages most of the Agencies and Monitoring Institutes, the integrated coordination represented an added value for the previous reporting exercises. Furthermore, the activities of the Regional Parks and the National Park are already geo-heritage-oriented and therefore the experience acquired in the definition of the geo-tourism potential and the responsible and sustainable tourism, will be particularly useful to steer the monitoring actions of the nominated property.In addition, it should not be forgotten that the high level of scientific knowledge, linked to the particular accessibility of the sites and the proximity to international university and research centres, leads to the publication of countless scientific articles every year. Most of these articles are related to research and monitoring of the main geological, biological, hydrological, floristic and faunistic factors. The monitoring reports are attached and an example of this extensive scientific production is available in the annex.

8. MANAGEMENT EFFECTIVENESS ASSESSMENT

For the nominated serial property, a procedure for assessing management effectiveness is proposed to support decision-making processes that underlie management and planning choices.

This procedure considers management as a cyclic and adaptive process which consists of a sequence of concatenated steps: definition of objectives, assessment of issues, implementation of measures, monitoring of results, and clarification of actions. The proposed procedure involves six main steps and is in line with the adaptive management models recommended by the IUCN/WCPA and adapted to the property. It is based on the need to preserve the universal values of the property and on the consideration of the different types and intensities of use that characterise each of the component parts. It is inclusive and participatory and is designed to assess sustainable development in natural environments that are located nearby inhabited centres.

The procedure is divided into the following phases:

- classification of areas based on the type of planned activities and the intensity of compatible uses;
- definition of management and planning objectives based on the classification of areas;
- definition of some easily measurable indicators, selected on the basis of management and planning objectives;
- definition of quality and performance standards (understood as desirable conditions and as objectives to be achieved or maintained; the standards for each area and situation of use are identified with the involvement of stakeholders);
- definition of a programme for regular monitoring of the effects of management actions and measures;
- assessment and possible rescheduling of management actions based on the results of monitoring.

9. WORK-PLAN TO IMPLEMENT THE OMS

The development of the strategy follows a program divided into 5 phases. The first of which corresponds to the nomination preparing phase.

STEP 1 (ACTIVITY CARRIED OUT)

Develop a draft overall management strategy

- activity: Identify a possible governance system;
Identify the management approach;
Define the vision and the main axes of management;
Prepare a coordinated management plan;
Develop a work plan.
- method: Multidisciplinary working group.
- actors: Technical Scientific Working Group; sharing with project partners (Emilia-Romagna Region, Appennino Tosco-Emiliano National Park, Ministry of Ecological Transition).

STEP 2

Improve management objectives and priorities

- activity: Establish a set of objectives, to be shared by project partners and set priorities;
Verify the coherence of the objectives with the management policies of the partners;
Verify the possibility of achieving the objectives in the short, medium and long term.
- method: Multidisciplinary working group.
- actors: to be defined (experts and officers of administrations and parks authorities).

STEP 3

Develop a participatory process of stakeholder engagement

- activity: Identify the main categories of stakeholders to be involved in the forming process of the management strategy (key stakeholders, institutional stakeholders, operating stakeholders, and supporters);
Define, integrate and develop management actions;
Identify priority actions.
- method: development of a participatory process on the basis of the main international standards applied to the needs of the World Heritage and the Operational Guidelines, to identify actions and possible implementers. The participatory process may use various engagement techniques in relation to different issues and different categories of stakeholders (e.g. multistakeholder workshops, partnerships on critical areas, dedicated listening lines, interviews and online consultations, focus groups, etc.).
- actors: to be defined.

STEP 4

Definition of a shared action plan

- activity: Analyse of the results of the participatory process;
Improve actions;
Define priorities;
Identify implementation measures (e.g. legislative, financial, contractuals, etc.).
- method: Multidisciplinary working group.
- actors: to be defined (experts and officers of administrations and parks authorities).

STEP 5

Strategy finalization

- activity: Define agreements to harmonize existing management systems for the preservation of the universal values of the property, consistent with the nomination vision;
Define agreements on priorities for the management and enhancement of the nominated property in implementation of the vision;
Develop common monitoring protocols (identification of a limited number of indicators to be monitored periodically);
Develop a plan for sustainable financing of the serial property;
Develop a system of evaluation of management effectiveness (based on the LAC model: performance indicators / quality standards).
- method: Multidisciplinary working group.
- actors: to be defined (experts and officers of administrations and parks authorities).

PROTECTIVE DESIGNATION

All the component sites of the nominated serial property possess a strong legal protection framework.

It consists of a coherent system of measures that link different levels of legislation (European, national, and local) protecting epigean and hypogean geological attributes of the candidate property and their natural habitats.

The overlapping levels of protection, which affect all the component sites of the nominated property, is a characteristic of the Italian - and European Union – context, where protected areas no longer generally coincide with wild, remote or virtually uninhabited areas of the Earth as elsewhere.

It stems from the will to increasingly strengthen the protection of natural ecosystems, commonly adjacent to areas where human presence is historicised and represents an integral part of the natural landscape.

In the case of the nominated property, the history of natural heritage protection began in the 1970s, with the establishment of the first parks and nature reserves, and continued with the constant refinement of protection up to the present day.

In particular, based on a law reforming the protected areas system, the protection structure has been further strengthened thanks to the transformation of some regional parks into national parks and the establishment of Natura 2000 sites on – but also outside - existing regional protected areas.

PROTECTIVE STATUS – CORE ZONE (ENTIRE SERIAL PROPERTY)

The great majority of the nominated Property core areas, 3,548 hectares (96.4%), is protected by European Community directives and corresponds to karst and gypsum habitats belonging to the European Natura 2000 network (IUCN Protection Category IV). The remaining part, 131 hectares (3.4%), is protected by law as Protected Landscape (IUCN Protection Category V) or are registered as Geosite of regional importance (IUCN Protection Category III).

The update of the General Measures of Conservation of Natura 2000 sites in 2018 (Resolution of the Regional Council of Emilia-Romagna No. 1147 of July 16, 2018) is the most recent protective measure which concerns the nominated property and overlaps with - but does not replace - earlier protective legislation, national and regional. In particular, the zones protected by the European directives include five areas - all previously established - which protect epigean and hypogean evaporitic karst environments both for environmental and landscape-cultural aspects. These five protected areas cover 2,597 hectares (71% of the nominated property). They are the Appennino Tosco-Emiliano National Park, established in 2001 (IUCN Cat. II), the Gessi Bolognesi and Calanchi dell'Abbadessa Regional Park, established in 1988, the Vena del Gesso Romagnola Regional Park, established in 2005, the Onferno Regional Reserve established in 1991 (all of them are IUCN Cat. IV), and the Collina Reggiana Protected Landscape, established in 2011 (IUCN Cat. V).

The entire subsurface area of the nominated property is registered thank to the law L.R. no. 9/2006 "Regulations for the conservation and enhancement of the geodiversity of Emilia-Romagna" as geological sites of regional importance (IUCN Protection Category III) and protected accordingly to the Parks Management Plans. Under this law, an inventory of geological sites, which includes caves, artificial cavities, and karst areas, has been established. Each geological site is mapped and illustrated by a descriptive sheet, which provides information on the protection measures.

Altogether, these protection measures form a consolidated system of environmental protection that has proven its effectiveness over time.

PROTECTIVE STATUS - BUFFER ZONE (ENTIRE SERIAL PROPERTY)

The buffer areas of each component site, being included entirely within the perimeters of the protected areas, also present the characteristic coexistence of several levels of protection, although in different proportions compared to the core areas.

The great majority of the buffer zone of the nominated property, 6,207 hectares (74.7% of the entire buffer zone), is protected by European Community directives and belongs to the European Natura 2000 network (IUCN Protection Category IV). The remaining part, 42 hectares (0.5%), is protected by law as national park (IUCN Protection Category II) or as regional protected area, 2,065 hectares (24.8%) (IUCN Protection Category IV and V).

For the detailed inventory of the protective designations see the synoptic table on page 46.

EXISTING PLANNING

The Regional Landscape Territorial Plan (PTPR), represents the reference planning tool for the verification of the current landscape-environmental protections. The PTPR of the Emilia -Romagna Region, approved by Regional Council in 1993 is a territorial plan focused on the landscape and the environmental values.

The regional plan is implemented through regional, intra-regional and sub-regional planning tools, which have specified and deepened the contents and provisions of the PTPR. Specifically, these implementation tools are provincial (Provincial Coordinating Territorial Plan, known as PTCP), metropolitan (Metropolitan Territorial Plan) and municipal (General Town Plan, known as PRG; Municipal Structural Plan, known as PSC, etc.).

The regional, provincial and municipal planning tools, according to their level of competence, represent the single protection reference on the regional policies for the territorial development programs. The control and supervision of the application of compliance with landscape protection regulations is under the responsibility of the Region, the Province and the Municipalities (Municipality, Association of Municipalities, Union of Municipalities, etc.) according to the planning level concerned in the territory.





MAP OF EUROPEAN PROTECTION OF THE NOMINATED SERIAL PROPERTY












MAP OF NATIONAL PROTECTION OF THE NOMINATED SERIAL PROPERTY








MAP OF REGIONAL PROTECTION OF THE NOMINATED SERIAL PROPERTY






MAP OF IUCN PROTECTION CATEGORIES OF THE NOMINATED SERIAL PROPERTY



it is agreed as follows:

ART. 1 – PURPOSES

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into by the signing parties in accordance with their institutional interests in order to carry out the actions required to support the nomination of the gypsum karst areas of the Emilia-Romagna Region for inscription on the UNESCO World Heritage List and expresses the commitment by the signing parties to cooperate and harmonize their actions in the territory in order to achieve this objective. The maps showing the gypsum karst areas of the Emilia-Romagna Region are attached to this Memorandum of Understanding.

ART. 2 - COMMITMENTS BY THE SIGNING PARTIES

By signing this Memorandum, the signing parties undertake to back and support the nomination of the gypsum karst areas of the Emilia-Romagna Region in each and every step of the relevant process as well as to establish an Institutional Committee as specified under art. 3 of this document.

Moreover, in synergy with the other local stakeholders, the signing parties undertake to cooperate in order to promote in the territories concerned, within their own competences and areas of action, any actions, projects, programmes and strategies for the development of the following main points:

- protection of the environmental balance and epigean and hypogean ecosystems;
- protection and preservation of the geosites and geological landscape of the gypsum areas;
- enhancement of the historical, cultural, social and archaeological aspects of the territories;
- environmental education of the local population and visitors of the protected areas and adjacent areas;
- sustainable development of the territory through best practices and the promotion of economic activities.

No direct burdens on the signing parties of this Memorandum are expected.

ART. 3 – INSTITUTIONAL COMMITTEE AND COORDINATION

An Institutional Committee, based at the Emilia-Romagna Regional Administration but with no economic burdens on the latter, is established in order to back and support the nomination process and promote the points under art. 2 in the territories.

If necessary, the Institutional Committee may create thematic and project focus groups on specific topics for the elaboration of the project, making use of the Working Group.

The Institutional Committee is chaired by the Assessor for mountain and inland areas, territorial planning and equal opportunities of the Emilia-Romagna Regional Administration and consists of the representatives of the signing parties.

The coordination of activities is carried out by the Emilia-Romagna Regional Administration, making use of the technical-scientific Working Group established by means of the resolution no. 12029 of 25/07/2018 by the General Manager for the Care for the territory and the environment. Such Working Group periodically discusses the progress of the nomination process with the Institutional Committee.

The Institutional Committee establishes the governance and general objectives of the overall strategy of management of these areas according to UNESCO standards.

After having consulted the Institutional Committee, the Executive Board of the Emilia-Romagna Regional Administration approves the Nomination Document to be submitted to the Italian National Commission for UNESCO.

ART. 4 – DEVELOPMENT OF ACTIVITIES AFTER RECOGNITION

After recognition, the signing parties of this Memorandum shall redefine their commitments according to the agreement with UNESCO in order to implement the management plan developed and established during the nomination process.

ART. 5 - TERM

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be in force for 4 (four) years as from the index date and may be renewed for further 4 years.

ART. 6 – WITHDRAWAL – VALIDITY - AMENDMENTS

Each party shall be allowed to withdraw from this Memorandum at any time by notifying the other parties of such decision.

The withdrawal from this Memorandum or the failure to sign it by one or more signing parties shall not void this Memorandum.

The parties agree that this Memorandum may be signed by additional parties wishing to enter into it, without requiring the existing signing parties to take any action in relation thereto. If the application for inclusion of the gypsum areas being nominated is rejected and thus the process of request for recognition as Unesco Heritage cannot be carried on, this Memorandum of Understanding shall become null and void.

The parties reserve the right to agree any amendments or supplements to this Memorandum by means of appropriate additional deeds.

ART. 7 DATA PROCESSING

The parties undertake that neither themselves nor their employees and collaborators shall disclose to third parties any confidential data, information, documents and news acquired as a result of this Memorandum.

The methods and purposes of processing of the personal data managed within the activities carried out in relation to this Memorandum shall comply with the principles of fairness, lawfulness and transparency as well as with the EU General Data Protection Regulation no. 679/2016 and with the Italian government decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003 as subsequently modified and supplemented.


ART. 8 – APPROVAL, REGISTRATION AND DISPUTES

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed for approval by the legal representatives of the parties concerned according to the relevant procedures required by law and by their respective by-laws.

This deed is exempt from stamp duty since it is signed between public corporations, pursuant to art. 16, table B, of the Italian presidential decree no. 642 of 26 October 1972, as modified by art. 28 of the Italian presidential decree no. 955 of 30 December 1982, and it will be registered if used. Registration expenses shall be borne by the party requesting registration.

Any dispute that may arise in relation to the execution of this Memorandum of Understanding which cannot be amicably settled shall be submitted to the competent body provided for by the laws in force.

After having been read and approved, this Memorandum is signed by means of digital signature pursuant to art. 15, par. 2-bis, of the Italian act no. 241/1990 as subsequently modified and supplemented.
